



## **POSTER ART COMPETITION**

### **RULES AND CHECKLIST**

The annual Concert on the Green Poster Art Contest is an excellent opportunity for students and their art programs. Winning students not only receive a scholarship or cash award, they receive recognition for their work and will have a copy of a juried piece for their portfolios.

#### **Students must meet the following requirements:**

- A school-age student residing in Clay County in grades 4 – 12
- Poster art covers an 11" x 12" section of an 11" x 17" paper or canvas (saving 5" on BOTTOM)
- Poster art follows this year's theme – "A Symphonic Celebration of the Arts"

#### **POSTER ART SUBMISSION GUIDELINES**

All submitted artwork is released to Concert on the Green for the exclusive use of Concert on the Green. Please keep in mind that submitted artwork may not be returned to you after the contest is over. If you need a copy for your portfolio, take a picture beforehand.

You must complete the following STEPS:

- STEP 1: Register your poster art ONLINE at [concertonthegreen.com](http://concertonthegreen.com)
- STEP 2: Fill out CHECKLIST SUBMISSION FORM (on next page)
- STEP 3: Attach CHECKLIST SUBMISSION FORM to the backside of your poster art
- STEP 4: Deliver your poster art by Feb. 7, 2020, to the Orange Park Town Hall

Winners will be announced on or before April 15, 2020 and the winning entries may be framed for use by Concert on the Green. The Clay County school program responsible for producing the winning poster will receive a program grant, in addition to recognition via Concert on the Green press releases and news articles.
